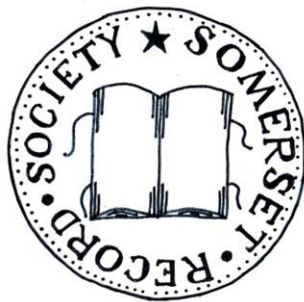




DROXFORD INDEX

An index to the *Calendar of the Register of John de Drokenford, Bishop of Bath and Wells (A.D. 1309-29)*, edited by [The] Right Rev[d]. Bishop Hobhouse, published by the Somerset Record Society in 1887. The *Calendar* is available online [here](#).

The original index concentrated almost exclusively on parishes and the clergy who served them, presumably because they were thought to be what the earliest members of the Somerset Record Society expected and wanted. The register is, as the Society's first Secretary declared, 'a mine of wealth' (p. vi), but the mine is now much more easily discoverable. It reveals, for instance, the many possessions Droxford brought with him as the fruits of long government service; the personal connections with Edward II and his youngest sister and his own ambivalent reaction to the 'sad public events' of 1321 (p. 193); the details of his personal household; and the busy public life of the bishop as he travelled not just to every quarter of his own diocese, but across the country, sometimes in support of the ministry of his fellow bishops. Most of the originally problematic place-names have now been identified, but otherwise the original text has been generally followed, with no attempt to check individual readings (e.g. the misreading of the last marginal heading on p. 153), nor to correct descriptions of individual documents (e.g. the document described as a terrier sewn on the edge of the original folio relating to Crewkerne on p. 219)¹.
